

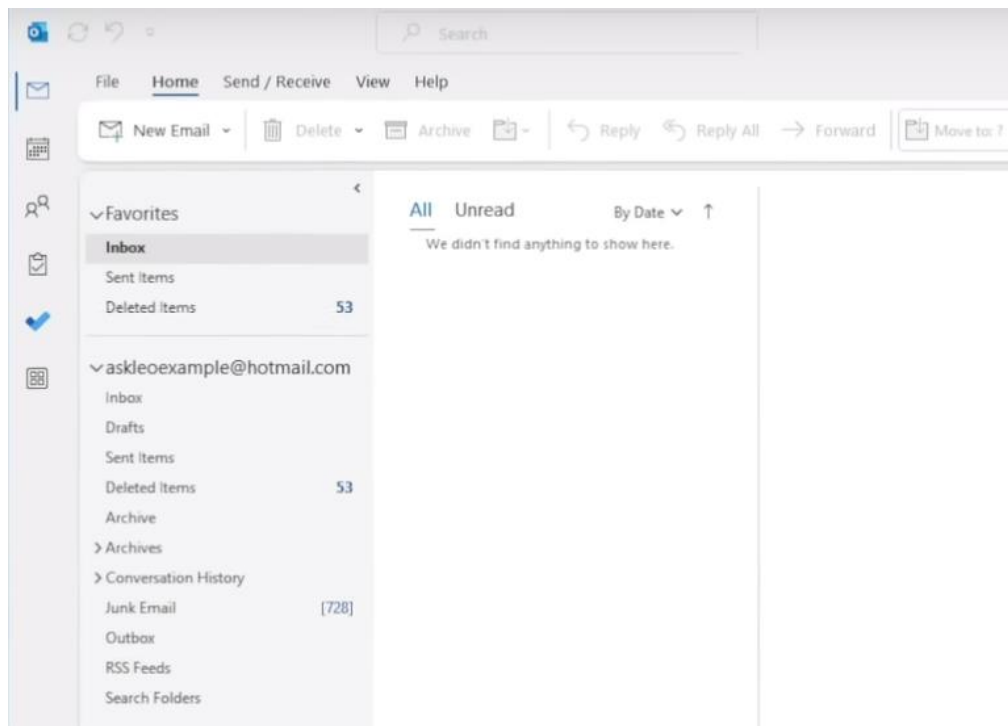
OUTLOOK

- Outlook.com

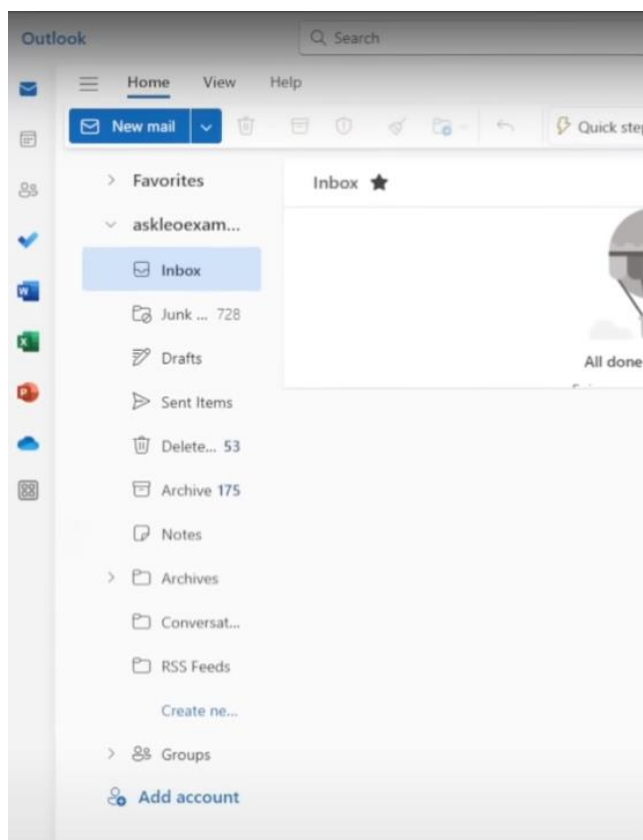
OUTLOOK

- Microsoft Outlook is an email client application that is part of the Microsoft Office suite. It is primarily used for managing email, calendars, tasks, contacts, and more.
- Microsoft Outlook can be installed on your computer or device, such as Windows or macOS, and is available as a standalone product or as part of Microsoft 365 (formerly Office 365) subscriptions.
- It provides a rich set of features for managing email, scheduling appointments, and organizing your personal and professional life.



WINDOWS OUTLOOK

- Windows Outlook (not the official name) is replacing the Windows Mail program in Windows 10 and 11. It is also installed on your computer and is a completely different and separate program from Office Outlook. You can also configure it to access any email service.



OUTLOOK.COM

- Outlook.com is a free web-based email service provided by Microsoft. It is a cloud-based email platform, similar to services like Gmail or Yahoo Mail.

It offers email, calendar, and contact management features and can be accessed through a web browser on various devices.

While Outlook.com shares the "Outlook" name, it is not the same as the Microsoft Outlook desktop application. They have some overlapping features but serve different purposes. Outlook.com is designed for online use, while Microsoft Outlook is typically used as a desktop email client.
