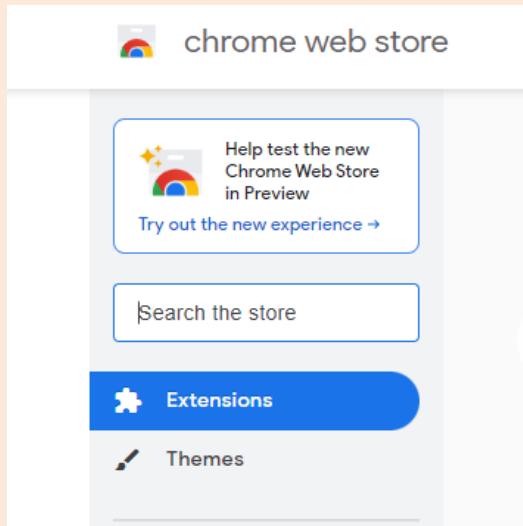


Extensions for your Browser

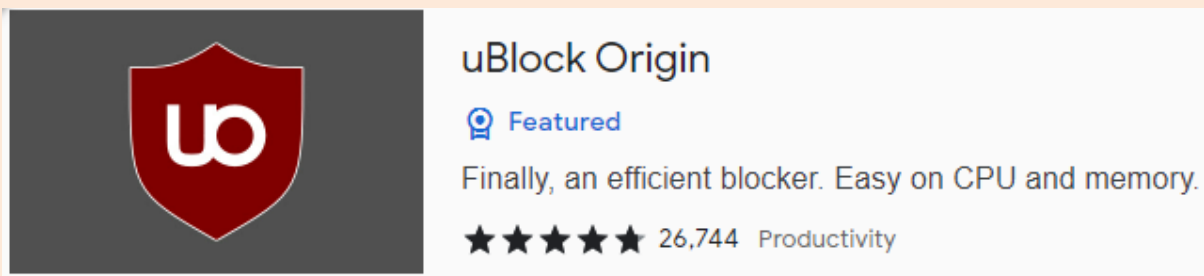
1. CHROME:

Open your Chrome Web Browser and go to the [Chrome Web Store](#).



On the left side of the web page ensure “Extensions” is selected, then in the “Search the Store” box type uBlock Origin.

There is one ad blocker that I recommend:

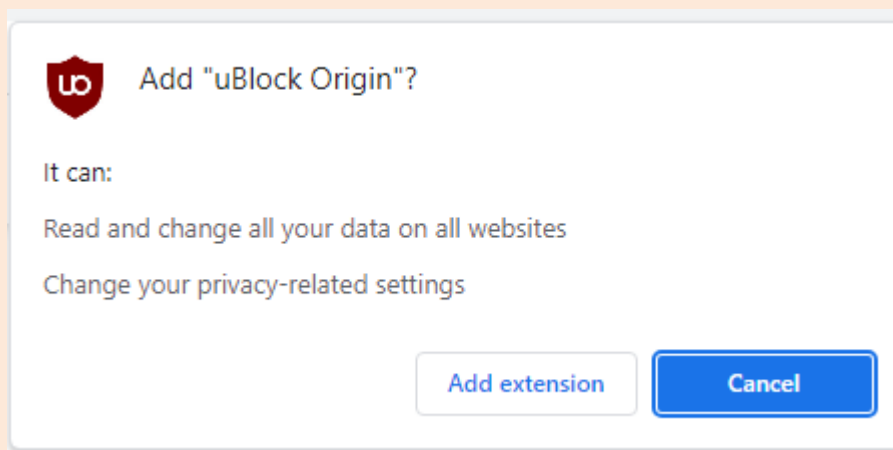


Click on the ICON and this page will open:



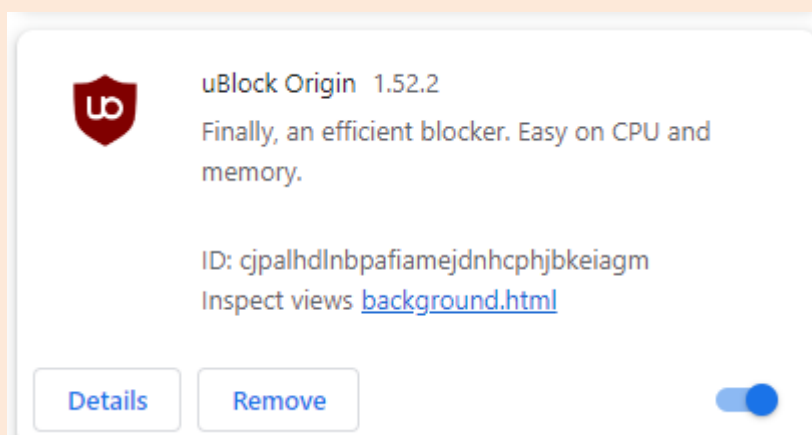
Click on “ADD TO CHROME”

A notice will pop. Read the notice and if that is what you want click on "Add Extension"



Another window will pop up stating UBlock Origin has been added to chrome.

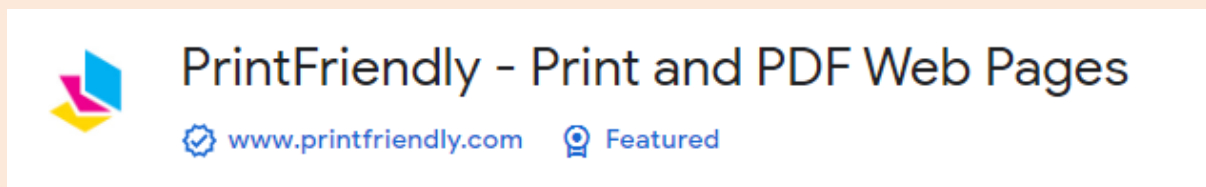
In Chrome click on the three dots in the upper right corner then on Extensions. You should see uBlock Origin listed:

Ad Block for You Tube and Web of Trust

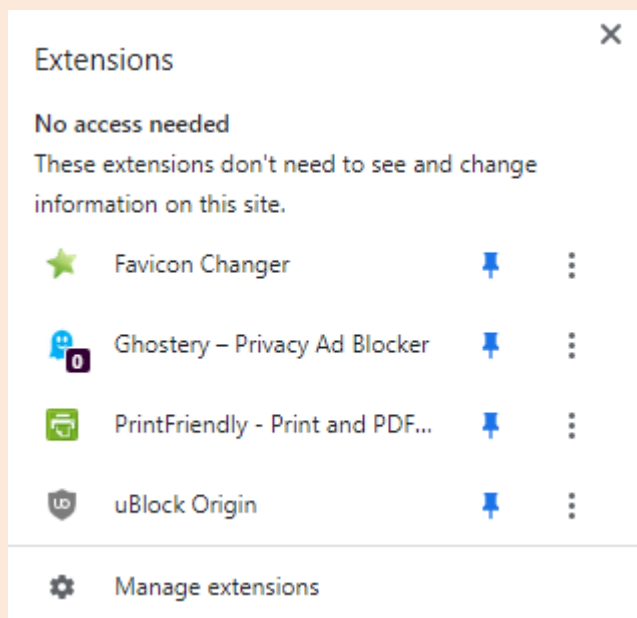


Print Friendly and PDF. Convert Web Page Article to a PDF.

Once you have Extensions Installed, open the Extension Manager. Click on the three dots in the upper right corner and in the drop down menu click on Extensions > Manage Extensions.

You will see a list of all the extensions you have installed with options to turn them on/off or remove (uninstall) them.


On the Chrome Tool Bar you will notice a small icon that looks like a jig-saw piece. This is a drop down list that shows all your extensions and a PIN option.




When you PIN an extension, its icon will appear on the tool bar to the left of the extension icon.

2. EDGE:

Click on the three dots in the upper right corner and in the drop down menu click on Extensions. Or click on the jig-saw looking

Icon  and in its drop down menu click on Manage extensions.

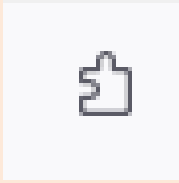

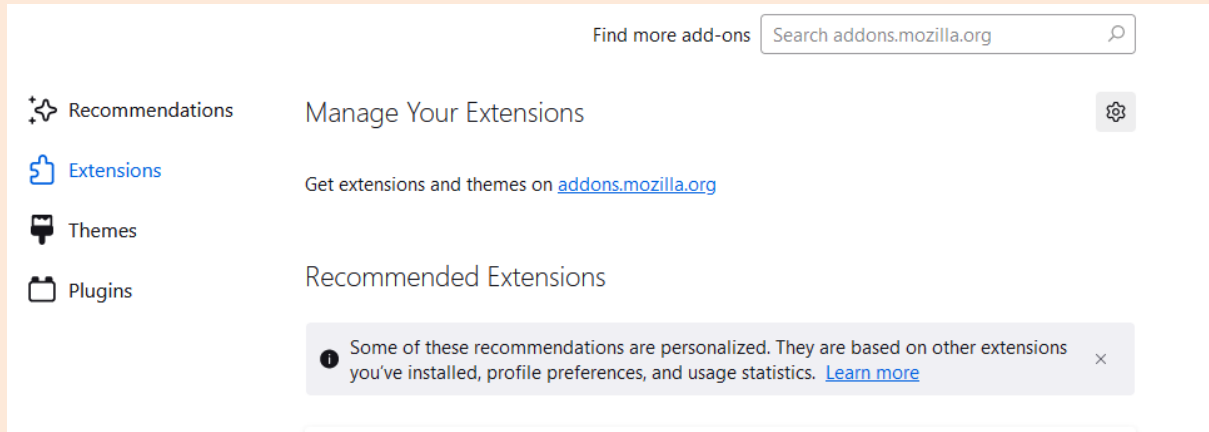
Click on “Get Extensions for Microsoft Edge”.

3. FIREFOX:



Firefox has an Extension Icon just like Chrome and Edge.



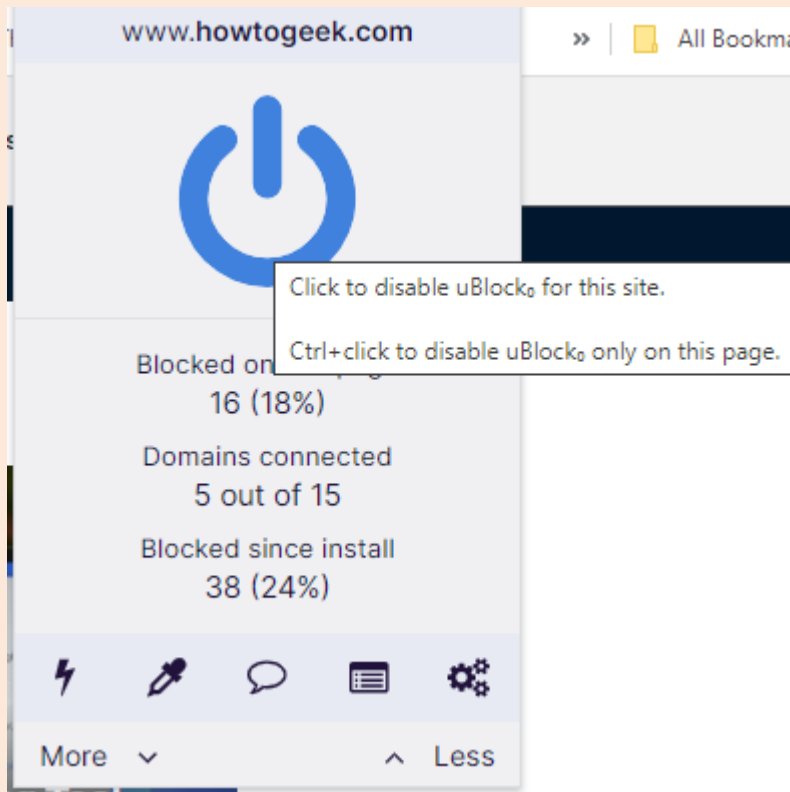
Firefox will give you a list of Recommended Extensions.

They also call them Add-ons.

Click on Addons.mozilla.org then search for ublock Origin.

Some web pages will not let you view the web page unless you turn off the Add Blocker or you can White List the Web Page

There are provisions to white list a web page by clicking on the uBlock Origin ICON on the tool bar.



To white list a page that is being blocked. Click on the UBlock Icon

Then CTRL + Click
